CITY OR ORGANIZATION.**

**→ EXPLAIN WHAT HAPPENED AND WHY IT IS
RELEVANT.**

SLIDE 4 (1 MIN)

KEY INSIGHT OR LESSON

- WHAT DID YOU LEARN?**
- WHAT WORKED, WHAT DIDN'T AND WHAT SURPRISED YOU?**
- INCLUDE ONE PRACTICAL TAKEAWAY.**

SLIDE 5 (1 MIN)

LOOKING AHEAD / DISCUSSION PROMPT

**→ END BY LINKING BACK TO THE ROUNDTABLE'S
CORE QUESTION.**

**→ OFFER ONE RECOMMENDATION OR POSE A
THOUGHT-PROVOKING QUESTION TO THE AUDIENCE.**

FINAL NOTES FOR PRESENTERS

- **Time limit:** 5 minutes maximum

- **Avoid:** Technical jargon, long lists or technical reports, or promotional content
- **Focus on:** Big-picture insights, relevance to South Caucasus and greater Central Asia (incl. Mongolia, Afghanistan)
